- Face Lift operations, facial fat injection, facial rejuvenation with dermabrasion, microdermabrasion and chemical (TCA) peelings.
- Laser removal of unwanted body hairs.
- Blepharoplasty, Repair of ptosis, and eyelid reconstruction for trauma or malignancies.
