Definition

☐ Schizophrenia is a disease of the brain

that manifest multiple signs and symptoms

involving thought, perception, emotion,

cognition and behavior.

Prevalence

√1-1.5%

DIAGNOSIS

(A). Characteristic symptoms:

Two or more of the following

- 1 Delusions
- 2 Hallucinations
- 3 Disorganized speech
- 4 Grossly disorganized or catatonic behavior
- 5 Negative symptoms (affective flattening, alogia or a volition).

Diagnostic Criteria Cont.

(B). Social / occupational dysfunction

(C). Duration

At least 6- month period and at least 1 - month in active phase

- (D). Schizoaffective and mood disorder exclusion
- (E). Substance / general medical condition

exclusion

Delusion (def)

- False (unreal) fixed (undiscussable) belief (idea) out of keeping with the patient social, cultural and educational background.
- A Disorder of thinking

1-Delusions of persecution

One or, someone close, is being persecuted.as:

- ✓ Being robbed (steeled).
- ✓ Being harmed.
- ✓ Being poisoned.
- Being followed.
- Being watched.
- Being shamed or humiliated publicly.

2-Delusions of reference

Behaviors of others negatively refer to oneself.

3-Delusion of grandiosity

- Inflated worth, wealth, power, knowledge, identity or special relation to famous persons.

4-Delusions of infidelity and jealousy

- Infidelity: one's sexual partner is unfaithful.
- Jealousy: non sexual partner (mother, sister).

Hallucinations

Definitions: false perception without a stimulus.
